Listen to God

Isaiah 55:4 “Indeed I have given him as a witness to the people, A leader and commander for the people.⁵Surely you shall call a nation you do not know, And nations who do not know you shall run to you, Because of the LORD your God, And the Holy One of Israel; For He has glorified you.”



Seek God

Isaiah 55:6 Seek the LORD while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near.⁷ Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the LORD, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.⁸ “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways,” says the LORD.
