STANDING IN FREEDOM

GALATIANS 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

²Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

JOHN 8:3 Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst,⁴ they said to Him, “Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act.⁵ Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?”

JOHN 8:10 When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, “Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?”¹¹ She said, “No one, Lord.” And Jesus said to her, “Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.”

GALATIANS 6:1 Brothers, if a man is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore such a one in the spirit of meekness, watching yourselves, lest you also be tempted.² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

ROMANS 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?² God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

WE HELP THEM UP

WE HELP THEM UP

MATTHEW 23:4 “For they bind heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on men’s shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers.”

WE HELP THEM UP

1 CORINTHIANS 12:26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

WE HELP THEM UP

GENTLY "in the spirit of meekness"

HUMBLY "lest thou also be tempted"

SYMPATHETICALLY "ye that are spiritual"

ECCLESIASTES 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

WE HOLD THEM UP

GALATIANS 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

WE HELP THEM UP

BURDEN ONE: Out of fellowship with God

1 JOHN 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

WE HELP THEM UP

BURDEN TWO: Wounded conscience

PSALM 32:4 For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; My vitality was turned into the drought of summer.

WE HELP THEM UP

BURDEN THREE: Fear and humiliation

GENESIS 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

WE HELP THEM UP

BURDEN FOUR: The accuser's voice

REVELATION 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, **for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.**"

GALATIANS 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

GALATIANS 6:2 ... and so fulfill the law of Christ.
