Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;²⁵ Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

Psalm 27:11 Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

Psalm 31:3 For thou art my rock and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.

The Age Factor

Exodus 2:11 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren.

The Life Factor

The Life Factor

2 Timothy 3:12 Indeed, **all** who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,¹³ while evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived.¹⁴ But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it,¹⁵ and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 11:26 He considered the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward.

The Life Factor

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Choosing

Choosing means that as we move through our life, we must make choices that will either be of faith or of sin.

Choosing means that our life moves from being a “live for today” to being a life that is a journey of saying “no” to our will and “yes” to God’s will.

Choosing means that our future and our destiny will so dominate our lives that the **trinkets, trials, or tests** will not cloud our vision of the eternal reward God promises to those who choose Him by faith.
