THE MAN OF GOD



Deuteronomy 33:1 Now this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death.





1 Timothy 6:11 But you, **O man of God**, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,¹⁷ that **the man of God** may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.



Hebrews 3:5 And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward,



Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in **all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.**

John 3:14 “And as **Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness,** even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,”

John 5:45 “Do not think that I shall accuse you to the Father; there is one who accuses you—Moses, in whom you trust.⁴⁶ For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for **he wrote about Me.**”



1 Corinthians 10:1 Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea,²all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea,³all ate the same spiritual food,⁴and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.



1 Corinthians 10:11 Now all these things happened to them as examples, and they were written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

Numbers 20:12 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, **Because ye believed me not**, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.



— THE PERSON MOSES WAS —

Exodus 6:20 Now Amram took for himself Jochebed, his father's sister, as wife; and she bore him Aaron and Moses. And the years of the life of Amram were one hundred and thirty-seven.

Leviticus 18:12 "You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father's sister; she is near of kin to your father."



— THE PERSON MOSES WAS —

Romans 6:17 But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.¹⁸ And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness.

— THE PERSON MOSES WAS —

Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,²⁵ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,²⁶ esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.

— THE PERSON MOSES WAS —

Exodus 33:7 Moses took his tent and pitched it outside the camp, far from the camp, and called it the tabernacle of meeting. And it came to pass that everyone who sought the LORD went out to the tabernacle of meeting which was outside the camp.⁸ So it was, whenever Moses went out to the tabernacle, that all the people rose, and each man stood at his tent door and watched Moses until he had gone into the tabernacle.⁹ And it came to pass, when Moses entered the tabernacle, that the pillar of cloud descended and stood at the door of the tabernacle, **and the LORD talked with Moses.**



— THE PERSON MOSES WAS —

Exodus 33:11 So the LORD spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. And he would return to the camp, but his servant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, did not depart from the tabernacle.



— THE PROBLEM MOSES BECAME —

John 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

John 9:28 Then they reviled him and said, “You are His disciple, but we are Moses’ disciples.²⁹ We know that God spoke to Moses; as for this fellow, we do not know where He is from.”



— THE PROBLEM MOSES BECAME —

2 Corinthians 3:13 And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:

¹⁴But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ.

¹⁵But even unto this day, when Moses is read, **the vail is upon their heart.**



— THE PROBLEM MOSES BECAME —

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

¹⁸But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are **being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.**
